### 1. Latest pamphlet

IMPACT 26: *'Powerful knowledge', 'cultural literacy' and the study of literature in schools*, by Robert Eaglestone, was published in June 2021. There was a well-attended online launch seminar, with guest speakers Barbara Bleiman, Bethan Marshall, Rachel Roberts and Nick Wallace. Unfortunately, the press release did not generate press coverage on this occasion. The pamphlet has been widely shared and discussed on social media and has an altmetric score of 91.

### 2. Future pamphlets

The next pamphlet will be IMPACT 27: *How can universities promote academic freedom? Insights from the front line of the gender wars*, by Judith Suissa and Alice Sullivan. The pamphlet is scheduled for publication in summer 2022.
